Where the stubborn old vines aren't generous but produce fruit with a bold personality. Where for years, I've dug in, gotten my hands dirty, and brought forth some of the best wine I've ever tried – Chelle Cabernet Sauvignon. This is its story.

This old apple farmer isn't Catholic, but you better believe attends St. Peter's pancake breakfast every Saturday.
